Motivational Interviewing in Small Moments for Impactful Change

with Marty Weems LCSW, LCAS

Motivational Interviewing (MI) is a collaborative evidence-based intervention designed to strengthen clients' intrinsic motivation for and commitment to change, in an atmosphere of acceptance and compassion. The workshop will begin with an overview of MI techniques and spirit. Marty Weems will provide examples and feedback on how to use MI to increase motivation and elicit change using a combination of didactic material, active role-plays, and consultation. Participants are encouraged to bring examples from their own practice.



Marty Weems LCSW, LCAS, is a Clinical Assistant Professor at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill School of Social Work. Marty joined the faculty at the School of Social Work in 2003, and teaches graduate studies in direct practice social work. Prior to her tenure at the School of Social Work, Marty worked as a treatment provider, with a focus on substance use disorders. In 2008 she founded e-daptivity Learning and Performance Solutions, an organizational development company that specializes in providing services to behavioral healthcare agencies
